A new year means new rates.

This past October, the Twin Oaks Landfill became the first facility in the country to eliminate tipping fees for its governing cities.

This means city-operated trucks from Bryan and College Station will pay \$0 to dump their municipal solid waste.

The standard tipping fee for non-city customers is still significantly lower than the statewide average at just \$30 per ton.

Residents coming to unload their personal vehicles will likely pay the minimum fee of \$3.

Other charges for special waste like oils, appliances, and tires will apply. You can find those rates under the “landfill” tab.

Before you throw something away, it is critical that you read over our list of “Household Hazardous Waste” items. Things like paint, cleaning products, and medications should not be put into your trash can. We’ve listed some alternate disposal options on our website.

Help us keep the Brazos Valley beautiful by putting a tarp or net over your load. Not only will the Twin Oaks Landfill charge you an extra fee, but the Texas Department of Transportation will cite you for it. Why risk it? Cover your load and keep the roads safe and clean.
