

Did you know that the Twin Oaks Landfill staff goes the extra mile to keep State Hwy 30 litter-free?

If you've ever driven past the landfill and seen a buggy or two on the side of the road, that's us!

Every Monday through Saturday, during operating hours, a team is assigned to scour a 4-mile stretch of Hwy 30 and pick up any litter or debris that might have fallen from a passing vehicle.

To recognize the staff's dedication to keeping the community clean, our Deputy Director, Samantha Best, decided to officially "adopt" that 4-mile stretch of Highway 30.

For our promise to maintain responsibility for the cleanliness of that stretch of highway, we were awarded an official "Adopt a Highway" traffic sign.

As you approach the landfill traveling either direction on Highway 30, you'll see a sign that reads "Adopt a Highway, next 4 miles, Twin Oaks Facility Staff."

This sign serves as a reminder that the Twin Oaks Landfill continues to do its part in keeping the Brazos Valley, and Texas, beautiful.
