

Anderson, TX– Did you know Twin Oaks Landfill is also home to the Twin Oaks Law Enforcement Training Facility?

According to the Bylaws, the Brazos Valley Solid Waste Management Agency, Inc was organized to “promote the common good and general welfare of the Cities.”

With such general terms, Executive Director Bryan Griesbach, says he knew this could be used as a way to give back to the community, with more than just a cost-effective landfill.

The Twin Oaks Landfill team worked closely with other city entities to determine the greatest needs of the community.

Previously renting the TEEEX Gun Range, both the Bryan and College Station Police Departments were in serious need of a training space of their own.

“It was a no-brainer at that point. It was good for both cities. It’s something they needed and something we were capable of hosting,” Griesbach said.

Fast forward several years later and the Twin Oaks Law Enforcement Training Facility is used for a variety of training purposes, including the BPD and CSPD Police Academies.

Twin Oaks Landfill also sponsors and works closely with other community organizations such as the Amber Alert Network of the Brazos Valley and Junior Leadership Brazos.
